Credit Transfer

'Credit Transfer' (CT) is a process that provides students with agreed and consistent credit outcomes for components of a qualification based on identified equivalence in contact and learning outcomes between matched qualifications

The granting of exemption or credit by a Registered Training Organisation to students for units of competency completed under accredited training.

ANIB accepts and provides credit to learners for units of competency where these are evidenced by;

- AQF certification issued by another RTO or AQF authorised issuing organisation
- Authenticated VET transcripts issued by the Registrar

Students can apply for a credit transfer through the credit transfer application at the commencement of course or as soon as possible.

All applications are to be submitted to Administration and students are to provide a certified colour copy or the original documents so that these can be sighted and copied.

Procedure

- 1.1 All students are provided with information about credit transfer at the enrolment and orientation process.
- 1.2 Students are to apply for a credit transfer through the credit transfer application at the commencement of course or as soon as possible
- 1.3 All applications are to be submitted to Administration and students are to provide original documents so that these can be sighted and copied by Administration and kept on file
- 1.4 If the course credit is granted before the student visa grant, ANIB will indicate the actual net course duration in the Coe issued for the student of that course
- 1.5 If the course credit s granted after the student visa grant, ANIB will report the change of course via PRISMS
- 1.6 All students who apply for credit transfer will be provided with a letter confirming the outcome of their application which must be signed or otherwise accepted by the student and be placed on the student file
